A Corridor-Wide Approach

Work with elected officials and communities to develop BQE vision and move projects forward






Central & Corridor-Wide Strategy



Traffic & Freight



Daily traffic on the BQE exceeds 130,000 vehicles, including 13,000 trucks.



New York is **extremely reliant** on trucks as a means of transporting goods, with almost all goods (89%) being brought into the city by trucks.



The BQE connects the Tri-State Area to all five boroughs of New York city. Close to **200 million tons** of freight move into, out of, or within the five boroughs every year.




BQE Structure — Viaduct








BQE Structure — Trench






Breakout Room Instructions - Mobile
